- Public facility type inoculations: After receiving the inoculation ticket, please make a reservation from the **call center** or the **reservation site**.

- * People with underlying illnesses should be vaccinated at a medical institution with an

emergency medical system. Please make your reservation for a large-scale mass inoculation site.

Reservations for large-scale group inoculation locations

Inoculation reservations cannot be made at city hall, branch offices, or health center counters.

Target underlying diseases, etc.

- 1. Those who are outpatients or hospitalized due to the illnesses described below.
- · Chronic respiratory illness
- · Chronic heart disease (hypertension)
- · Chronic kidney disease
- · Chronic liver disease (cirrhosis, etc.)
- Diabetes mellitus that is being treated with insulin and diabetes mellitus that is coexisting with other illnesses.
- · Blood illnesses
- · Illness that reduces the function of immunity
- · Those receiving treatment such as steroids that lowers the function of immunity.
- Neurological disorders and neuromuscular disorders due to abnormal immunity
- Those for which body functions are declining due to a neurological disorder or a neuromuscular disorder.
- · Chromosome abnormality
- · Severe psychosomatic disorder
- · Sleep apnea syndrome

· Serious mental illnesses.
